Christopher Campbell is the current Executive Director of the Vermont Telecommunications Authority (VTA). Prior to coming to the VTA, Chris provided more than a decade of service to the state of Vermont on matters related to technology and policy. He served as Assistant Chief Technology Officer for the State of Vermont; he also directed the Telecommunications Division of the Department of Public Service. In these roles he worked to formulate policy related to telecommunications and other technology, including expansion of broadband and mobile infrastructure and services. He has also served as Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Information and Innovation, which provides telecommunications and information technology support and coordination to Vermont state government, and as Director of Network Infrastructure for the Office of Economic Stimulus and Recovery. He currently serves on the board of the Good Samaritan Haven in Barre, Vermont. Chris grew up in Colchester, Vermont. He received his B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and a Master of Regional Planning degree from the University of Massachusetts-Amherst.
